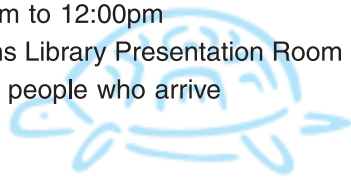

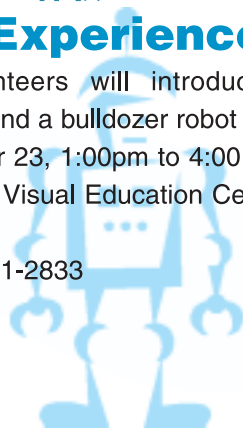

Iwaya Observatory Course

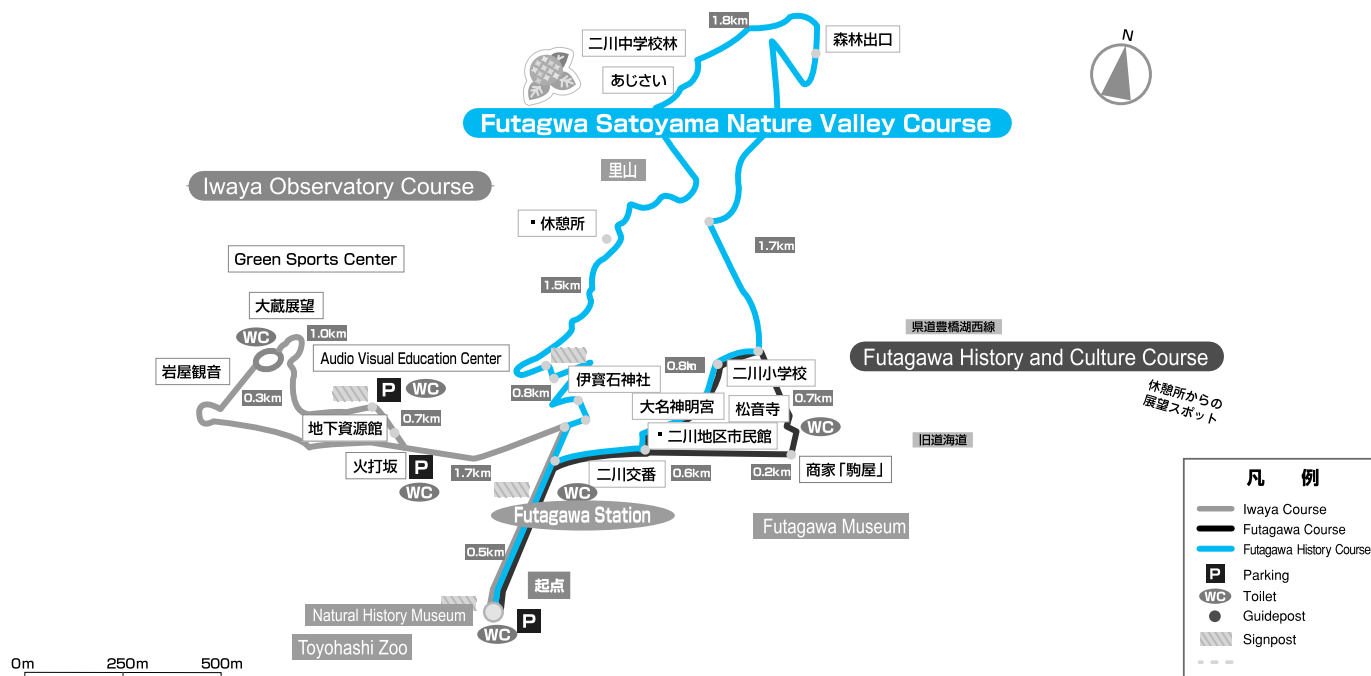
This course takes participants near the observatory, the Adventure Fort Play Land, and down a Nature Trail.
