Avoid making loud noises at night.

Loud voices and sounds can disturb people living near the beach.
Please avoid making noise at night.

Let's keep our beaches clean.

Don't throw trash in the ocean. Please take your trash home and use facilities (such as restrooms) with care.



Be careful when making fires.

Open fires are prohibited on the beach.

The endangered loggerhead turtles lay their eggs on the Omotehama coast.
From May to October, try to avoid making noises at night time until dawn so that the turtles can lay their eggs and return to the ocean.



Let's avoid accidents on the beach.

Please refrain from going near or beyond the wave-dissipating blocks, as the sand around them may suddenly sink or collapse. Be careful when there is a rapid rip current that may drag you away from the shore. Stay away the beaches when there is a typhoon or other extreme weather.
