There are many students attending part-time, correspondence, and boarding schools who want to study while working, or are worried about their past truancy (school non-attendance) or difficulties socializing.

Toyohashi City will hold an information session to support young people who are having difficulty going to school, leaving their home, or have other anxieties or issues in regard to high school. Each school will have its own booth where those interested can go to learn more about the school and speak with school staff directly. We hope that learning about the strengths and characteristics of each school can become an opportunity for you to find a future career!






◆ If coming by car Please use the HOIPPU parking lot
